Drug Use and Abuse Special Edition: Heroin

TOMS RIVER - Ocean County Prosecutor Joseph D. Coronato has called the abuse of heroin an epidemic and has enlisted many local people and agencies in the battle to eliminate it.

Ocean County Library will present "Drug Use and Abuse Special Edition: Heroin" at seven branches during the next three months to bring awareness of the issue in communities of Ocean County.

Led by Lt. Joe Pangaro, participants will discuss the history of the epidemic and learn ways they can detect if someone they know is using it. He will also discuss the legal consequences if one is caught using or dealing the drug.
