### **Ocean County Library to host “The Magic of Chad Juros”**

**TOMS RIVER** - The Ocean County Library will host “The Magic of Chad Juros,” a family-friendly show that will feature magic, music, comedy, and audience participation at five branches in July and August.

Juros has performed and lectured worldwide. He is the youngest magician to ever perform at the White House and has been featured on several television programs, including Food Network’s “Dinner: Impossible” and A&E’s “Criss Angel Mindfreak.”

Chad Juros is noted for his charity work, including motivational speaking and performing for children’s hospitals. Juros was diagnosed with leukemia at the age of three in 1991, and survived, noting the importance of magic and entertainment in maintaining a positive attitude.
