

2016 Health Coverage Under the Affordable Care Act: Small Businesses

Small Business Health Options Program (SHOP) Marketplace

The SHOP Marketplace is open to businesses and non-profit organizations with 50 or fewer full-time equivalent employees. If an employer enrolls in SHOP and has 25 or fewer employees, they may qualify for a Small Business Health Care Tax Credit. However, businesses with 50 or fewer employees are NOT required to offer health benefits to their employees

- Offer a health plan only, health and dental plans, or a dental plan only
- Meet the SHOP Marketplace minimum participation rate more easily.
- Renew your SHOP Marketplace coverage online, without having to fill out a new application. Many parts of your existing application will be saved and pre-populated, including the employee roster.
